

APP FOR TYPING IN INDIAN LANGUAGES ON ANDROID CELLPHONES

For ability to type in Indian languages on Android system cellphones:

First, install an app called MULTILING by Honso, and after that a few required plug-ins.

It is a multi-step process, but is simple.

After installing all of the above go to your setting of the phone
